



Books range in price from 50 cents to \$15, and some are even signed by professors like Larry Speck!




Firm Tours


FORUM

Every year, the Texas Society of Architects puts on their Design Expo. This is one of the largest architecture conventions in the country, and it is **free** for students!


This year's convention is **Oct 24-25** in Galveston. If people are interested, we can organize a club trip to the convention!
